Will perform spot checks on incoming glulam supplies and outgoing glulam products. Will perform daily in-line and off-line QC testing procedures and daily checks during production.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

TECHNICIAN:

- Perform basic QC testing procedures and assessments required for daily production.
- Ensure glulam adhesive is within specification for spread weight and ratio.
- Perform daily plant condition checks.
- Perform data entry tasks for QC spreadsheets.
- Communicate with detailing department for clarification, when required.
- Responsible for ensuring products are within dimensional tolerance and tolerance for framing accuracy.
- Make sure that all quality issues are documented and communicated to the Quality Control Manager
- Oversee production to ensure quality requirements are met.
- Enforce corrective actions from plant manager to production personnel.
- Communicate professionally and courteously with customers and visitors in a tour group setting.
